## About RRND

We are actually two Clubs in one, Reigate & Redhill North Downs Motor Club was founded in 1935 and is affiliated to the ACU (Auto Cycle Union). In 1993 the Reigate & Redhill North Downs Motorcycle Club was founded and is affiliated to the AMCA (Amateur Motor Cycle Association). It was necessary to form a second Club, as one Club cannot affiliate to both organisations and we wanted to run our Club trials under the AMCA but also remain associated to the ACU to give our members a wide choice of events to ride in. We are also affiliated to

the BMF (British Motorcyclists Federation) through the AMCA Club. Although the main interest is motorcycle trials we still welcome all motorcyclists as members, many of our members also have road bikes and a wide interest in motorcycling and organise many road trips.

The Club runs monthly trials (under the AMCA) on Sundays and also evening trials during the summer (June, July and August). At Club trials we normally lay out 8 sections run over 5 laps with a break after two and have four or five routes.



### **Congratulations Fin- 20 years in business.**

Most RRND members will be familiar with Fins Motorcycles in Hockley Business Park, Hooley Lane, Redhill, and a number of us were fortunate to be able to join Fin and his staff early last month to celebrate 20 years of business. With Don Barrett shutting his shop in 1986 Fin Reynolds saw the opportunity to provide motorcycle servicing in the area. He started in a small unit in the business park and has now spread into adjoining units to provide a well stocked shop and a large showroom stocked with sensibly priced second -hand machines. The original unit has now become the workshop and MoT test area.

A party was held in the local - The Marquis of Granby - and went well into the small hours. It was good to see former RRND member and Fin mechanic Robin Sherlock at the party having made the journey up from Dorset. The Sherlock family have a long association with RRND and Ken, Robin's father, used to run the workshop for Don Barrett.

Although Fin prefers the cut and thrust of circuit racing to trials both he and several of his current staff have ridden with the Club. They can offer advice, servicing and repairs for all trials and road machines. A discount is generally available to RRND members on stock items from the shop. ### **Beginner Training trials.**

Incredibly only one training session remains this year. With one exception all sessions have been well attended without being crowded

giving ample time to give advice, chat, and try things out, all without the pressure of a normal trial. During the course of the year we have experimented with different formats, and have now reverted to a standard two route (yellow and easy red) punchcard format. This actually frees Malcolm and I (and any other helpers) to circulate or to give specific attention to an individual. The Tilburstow Hill venue is ideal being easy to access, non-threatening, and surprisingly versatile. With access to the fields alongside the wood normally used we can take complete beginners and gradually introduce them to the trial format. The weather at the last trial on 6th September became worse and worse as the day went on, yet we were reasonably well protected in the wood. The poor light made photography a challenge though! Despite the rather poor results I have asked Bruce to post them on the website because I feel they really capture the fun and relaxed atmosphere. On average we have gained two new members for every session.

The last training trial is in November. We did hold one in October because of the direct clash with the Old Codger Trial, and in December it would clash with the ACU Star group trial run by this club. With a club trial scheduled for the last week in December unless something unforeseen occurs I would intend to recommence the trials on the first Saturday of February- keep an eye on the Whats On section.

### **Evening Trial- Beare Gill**

We came to the end of our series of three evening trials with a familiar dilemma facing us- do we heed the weather forecast and cancel or do we go ahead? In the end it was not practical to delay the trial due to other fixtures, and the fear that with poor weather forecast for some time it would be impossible to move the trial any further back because of the

limited evening light. Perhaps concern over the weather was the reason that we were down on numbers but a reasonable field enjoyed some good sections at all levels followed by the customary barbecue provided by the "two lovelies". Jan and Jo. A big thank you to them as the provision of the barbecue means a lot of work (and cleaning) but really adds to the social atmosphere. No photographs for this event I am afraid as I was riding and although a few people were still circulating when I finished the light was very poor. On that note we have no photographs for the subsequent Club trial at Dunsfold although I think there must be some around of the camping weekend at least. The magazines produced over the summer have been excellent, with news and articles as well as results. In part this was due to combining some of them to a two month period. To assist David and to try and continue this standard the committee have decided that the magazine will be produced bi-monthly in future. This will mean that David will be able to publish a schedule of publication and we should be able to support him by producing adequate copy. If you ride or attend any event - particularly something outside the club like a long distance trial - lets have an article telling us about it. Perhaps some of the younger riders would like to let us know how they got on at events and what they thought of them?

### Lastly

The weather has caused problems accessing some of the grounds we would normally use for Club trials at this time of the year hence there has been little shown on the schedule. Please keep an eye on "Whats On" on the website for confirmation of venues- whatever happens we will be running a full programme of events.
