Barry Tickner had to settle for second position after finishing level with Matt Wakeford on 161 points each, I believe Matt had more wins and was therefore awarded first place. Also finishing in second place was Nick Burr Snr. in the pre 67A class and that's not all. The final youth results are as follows, Nick Burr Jnr was first, Matthew Don second, Karl Wooster third, James Lloyd Jacob fourth and Lewis Taylor fifth and all of them are members of RRND, WELL DONE.

On page 9 you will find the final results for the 2005 Club championships, don't forget that the awards will take place at the Club AGM to be held at the Dog & Duck pub, Outwood on 15th February at 8.00pm, so make sure you don't miss it.

The Club will be holding the annual dinner dance on 11th March at the Reigate Manor hotel, Reigate Hill, full details will be printed in the February newsletter.

The next Club trial will be at Hookwoods on the 22nd January, if you've not been there before it's an excellent piece of land with many man-made obstacles and some

of the best rock sections to be found in this part of the country.

Christmas Club Trial Tuesday 27th December

The Christmas trial is the same every year, we always have a good turnout of up to 70 riders of which a small percentage are either beginners or new members. Unfortunately these riders find the conditions at Don Barretts very hard to cope with, which means quite a few of them usually go home disappointed.

This year we purposely laid out a nice easy red route so everyone would go home happy. The blue route was at its usual standard. The white route was a little easier than the last few trials but was more to the correct standard thanks to Pat Lloyd-Jacob who laid out this course. I was very surprised at the end of the trial to see Pat's bike with no mud guards at all!

The other sections were laid out by Keith Cross (red), Roger Farmer (blue) and Dave Wooster (yellow).

On the day the weather did not ruin it as it stayed dry all day apart from 15 minutes of snow just as section 2 was being set out earlier in the morning. By the afternoon the top slippery surface started to dry out which favoured the riders who had taken their time on the first 2 laps. The white riders always take longer looking at the sections so they had the most improved scores for the last 3 laps.

Overall another successful trial thanks to the members who gave their time to layout and to those who helped clear away at the end.

The next Club trial is at Hookwoods and is well worth making the effort to get to as it is an excellent piece of land. Richard Coles has hopefully found us some new land to use, so watch out for possible venue changes in May and July. We will keep you posted but the trial dates will remain the same.

Star Group Trial – December

Yet again our star group trial was a great success. All 14 sections were manned by club members who all knew how to score riders properly and put on a top quality trial.

The scores on the day were all about right so no riders had a too easy or too hard a day. Many riders at the end of the trial said how much they had enjoyed it, and for me to thank all the club members who had helped on the day.

This year as a Club we have achieved our best result for a very long time. Only Antony Read can remember when we were better than third place, so it must have been in the good old days before mono shock and water cooled engines! There are now more riders than ever riding for our Club and as the ten best scores for each Club count and every finisher gets points, sheer weight of numbers really helps as many of the other Clubs only field 5 or 6 riders, so when we roll up with 10 or 12 riders we can't loose no matter how good we are. Fortunately we do also have some very good riders as well who regularly score maximum points. As you can see from the scores (*see page 11*) Stuart Read won outright and Barry Tickner only missed out by the narrowest of margins for 2nd in class. This year we will be able to take second or even first if we carry on entering in large numbers.

Last month we ran our round of the Star Group championship and whilst some considered it to be a blessing I was disappointed that we had no sidecar entries due to the Sidecar Southern Experts Trial being held on the same day. The conditions were slippery but the sections were sensibly laid out to suit and as a result there were no retirements and no complaints only compliments. Thank you to everyone who helped make this another successful trial. Although Stuart did not win the trial he has secured the Best Expert in the Championship, the first Club member to win this title for 20 years.

How The Handicaps Work

The idea of the Handicap Championship is so that all riders no matter what sort of bike they ride or which sections could compete for one championship. At most Club trials there are 5 laps of 8 sections making a total of 40, the maximum loss of marks would therefore be 200 if one fived every section. Each riders handicap is worked out on the difference between what you actually loose and 200. Therefore if I got it right your handicap added to your score would equal 200. The Handicap winner at the end of the year should therefore be the rider who has improved the most. In addition to awards being given to championship winners, the handicap winner of each club trial also receives an award.

Directions: Hookwoods is located just off the A246 Guildford to Leatherhead Road at West Horsley, (on the left if coming from the Leatherhead direction), RRND signs will be placed near entrance on the day.

Course: Five laps of eight sections with a break after two. It is preferred that riders ride the course as laps starting at which ever section they prefer and not keep riding a section continuously.

Sections: This trial will have four routes and there will be a break after two laps when sections may be changed.

General: Please note all Parents/Guardians are responsible for under 18 year old riders and it is required that you sign their entry form. Also schoolboy/girl riders do not have personal insurance cover, only third party. For safety reasons it is preferred that riders do not ride around the course alone but in small groups observing each other in the sections. Always check that the section is clear before entering and no practicing before or during the trial in the sections, if caught practicing you may be disqualified.

Helmets are optional but you are strongly advised to wear one. All under 17 riders MUST wear a helmet!
